The General Prosecutor's Office received a repeated supervisory appeal against the decision of the Oktyabrsky District Court of the City of Minsk dated July 12, 2018, upheld by the ruling of the Judicial Panel for Civil Cases of the Minsk City Court of September 10, 2018, on dismissing the claims of Nikolas Cheropoulos against L.A. Trafimovych regarding the return of the children.

The General Prosecutor's Office had previously considered the supervisory appeal against these court orders. The Deputy General Prosecutor refused to bring a supervisory protest, as specified in a substantiated response.

In accordance with Article 436 of the Civil Procedure Code, supervisory appeals must be submitted within one year from the date of entry of the court order into force.

Supervisory appeals filed after the specified deadline shall not be subject to consideration.

The deadline established by law for appealing a court decision that has entered into force has expired. This deadline is preclusive and cannot be restored.

Subject to the foregoing, a repeated supervisory appeal cannot be considered on the merits and is returned.
