Today Christian Vision learned that the City Council of Winchester in England has decided that St Elizabeth's will not be able to participate in the Christmas market in their city due to their support for the war. Various civil society organizations approached the city council with a request to ban the participation of the Minsk monastery in the Christmas market.

The Christmas market in Winchester is one of the largest in the UK, with more than 350 thousand visitors a year. Participation in such an event is an opportunity to earn significant financial resources, as well as popularize the activities of your organization.
