Dear parishioners and friends of the monastery! Christ is Risen!

False information has spread on the Internet that the sisters of the St. Elisabeth Monastery and some of our priests have become infected with coronavirus infection MASSIVELY. In particular, this information is being disseminated by priest Alexander Shramko, who was banned from serving for violating the priestly oath, and, in his words, by various opposition resources. Neither o. Alexander and representatives of these media outlets did not bother to contact the monastery to confirm the accuracy of the information they published.

In this regard, we decided to tell you about what is really happening.

As of April 22, 2020, there are no confirmed diagnoses of COVID-19 among the clergy of the monastery.

Priest Artemy Tonoyan is on sick leave because he has gumboil and sinusitis.

Priest Alexander Pashkovsky has pneumonia, but the disease proceeds without complications, and therefore, according to the results of a medical examination, he does not need hospitalization and is undergoing treatment while at the dacha.

Fathers Sergius Nezhbort and Sergius Faley have the initial stage of the disease (ARVI symptoms), so its etiology has not yet been determined.

Friend of our monastery Fr. Vasily Lesko, 92 years old, is indeed in intensive care with a diagnosis of pneumonia, but he is not a clergyman of our monastery and did not participate in Lent and Easter services in our monastery.

Two sisters of the monastery (out of 130) have a confirmed diagnosis of COVID-19. This is nun Alexia (Yudina Elena Vladimirovna) and nun Paraskeva (Gornostaeva Svetlana Vasilievna). Both of them are in the hospital.

Nun Maria (Lidiya Ivanovna Litvinova), who lived with the sick nun Paraskeva, was hospitalized on April 22, 2020 and is awaiting test results.

Nun Anfisa (Adamovich Natalya Evgenievna) was ill with a high fever, was examined, is currently in her cell, her condition is stable, test results are awaited.

Novice Zinaida (Dubanevich Zinaida Iosifovna) was sick with a high fever, was examined, and was not hospitalized.

We also have sisters with seasonal ARVI, so the monastery has taken the recommended precautions, the temperature is measured daily, sick sisters live separately, and they are provided with medical care.

We kindly ask everyone who does not have reliable information not to spread fake messages on the Internet! Hope for understanding.
