

PSYCHOLOGICAL QUALIFICATION

Test subject: Anthie Anthoula Cheropoulou, born on June 08, 2012.

Survey date: June 06, 2018

The grounds for the conduct: ruling of the Oktyabrsky District Court of the City of Minsk dated June 05, 2018.

Purpose: to study the level of attachment of the child to each of the parents and identify the level of emotional connection of the child with each of the parents, the presence of signs of adverse effects of the parents on the child.

Used methods:

1. Semi-structured interview, observation;
2. "Two houses" technique by I. Wandvik, P. Ekblad;
3. Sociometric test "Birthday";
4. "Family drawing" method;
5. René Gille method

Diagnostics report and interpretation

The work with the child was carried out in the absence of the mother. The girl was open for a communication with a psychologist, agreed to go through the proposed tasks. In the conversation with the girl, a little tension was felt when it came to parents.

Semi-structured interview

In a conversation with a psychologist, the girl said that she lived in Minsk with her mother, sister Alexandra, aunt Lena (mother's friend). She used to live in Sweden, where her dad Nikolas stays now. The girl believes that she looks like dad, she has the same nose, and she likes this resemblance. Anthoula loves to paint, play with her sister, go to church with her mother.

The following dialogue took place between the psychologist and the girl:

P: Do you see dad?

A: Yes, he rarely comes to us, we go to a restaurant, eat ice cream, mom is also with us. We are like a family, only dad in Sweden, and we are here.

P: Does dad call you?

A: Yes, he always calls on weekends, and on weekdays in the evening. He loves me very much.

P: Would you like to visit dad?

A: I would like to visit my dad, but it's better with mom. She cooks deliciously, bathes us, dresses us.

Sociometric test "Birthday"

It allows to determine the most significant family members for the child and their emotional distance.

The girl invited mom, sister Alexandra and dad to her birthday (in that order). These are significant, important figures for her. Mother and sister sit next to Anthoula, dad is a little father away. The location of people characterizes the psychological distance between them and Anthoula. The closest people for a girl are a sister and a mother.

"Two houses" technique by I. Wandvik, P. Ekblad

It is focused on identifying family members communication with whom is most desired for the child.

The girl placed herself, mother and sister Alexandra in the neighboring rooms of the red house,. Dad also lives in the house, but there are several rooms between them. In addition to them, the child identified places for other relatives and acquaintances of the family with whom she would like to maintain relations (uncle Vadim, aunt Maria, Mother Nina, etc.).

René Gille method

It allows to determine the attitude towards the mother, father and other family members, to identify which of the parents is the most significant for the child, whose opinion is the most authoritative.

The child is offered situations in which she makes a choice. A positive emotional attitude is manifested in the choice of a closer distance. In all the tasks Anthoula chooses her place closer to her mother. In situations of choice (with whom you will go for a holiday, with whom you will go to the doctor, with whom to share the trouble, etc.), the girl also prefers her mother.

Family drawing

This technique allows identify whom the child considers his or her family, how he or she relates to the people depicted, how comfortable he or she feels in the family.

Anthoula considers herself, mother and sister, as members of her family. In the drawing, the sisters are on either side of the mother, all three are holding hands. This indicates emotional closeness between family members. People's clothes are painted in bright colors, there are eyes and smiles on the faces, which indicates a positive perception of her family by Anthoula.

At the same time, the girl began to draw her family with the figures of a psychologist and her daughter, postponed the implementation of the relevant task in time, which may indicate unsatisfactory family situation related to the discord between the parents.

Conclusions:

Anthoula demonstrates emotional affection for both mother and father. The child has the closest relationship with the mother, the father is present in all tasks (except for the family drawing), but a little farther away. The figures of both parents and the relationship with them are positively colored in the girl's view. Since the parents do not live together and there is discord between them, the girl experiences anxiety and tension when it comes to the family. She wants to see her father, to visit him, but to live with her mother.

Recommendations:

1. Mothers should facilitate communication between daughter and father.
2. Mother and father should speak about the other parent in a neutral or positive way.
3. Parents must resolve their personal issues exclusively between themselves without using the child as a means of influencing each other.
