In response to your statement on violation of rights of minors and on transfer of minors to a legal guardian, we inform you as follows.

Minor children Anthie Anthoula Cheropoulou and Alexandra Cheropoulou reside together with their mother, Liudmila Arkadyevna Trafimovich, at the following address: 64–24 Kizhevatova Street, Minsk.

The mother takes care of upbringing and support of her minor daughters.

In accordance with the inspection report on housing and upbringing conditions of the minors issued by specialists of the public educational institution “Social and Paedagogical Centre of the Oktyabrsky District in Minsk”, it was determined that the well-furnished 3-room flat has the conditions necessary for life and upbringing of the minor children.

Anthie Anthoula Cheropoulou and Alexandra Cheropoulou attend the public educational institution “Nursery and Kindergarten No. 480” in Minsk. The mother has a permanent job and a stable income.

As L. A. Trafimovich clarified, the minors’ father, Nicolas Cheropoulos, has been providing financial aid for his children since May 2018. He keeps in touch with the children once a week by phone. When the father comes to Minsk, the girls are eager to engage with him.

During a visit to the family, it was additionally explained to the minors’ mother, L. A. Trafimovich, that in accordance with Articles 75, 76 and 77 of the Code of the Republic of Belarus on Marriage and Family, both parents have equal rights and obligations in upbringing their children, and the parent who resides separately from the children has the right to communicate with them and is obliged to participate in their upbringing, while the parent with whom the children live is not entitled to prevent the other parent from communicating with them and participating in their upbringing.
